General Comments:

An inspection was conducted at Lola's Birria on this date after a complaint for a fire was made to this department by Murrieta Fire Department. Inspector spoke to person in charge Miguel at the time of inspection and Murrieta Fire inspector Jeff Bruns. Murrieta fire states water originated from a sprinkler head adjacent to the walk in cooler above the dry storage racks. Fire originated from the used towels hamper adjacent to the walk in cooler. Pooling water was observed throughout the kitchen, in the dining room, in the front service station affecting opened food and clean utensils. Observed the FRP paneling at the fire location to be severely burned and in need of replacing. At this time this facility is closed due to no power, gas, and having multiple foods/food contact surfaces contaminated with waste water.

The following items were observed to be affected from contaminated water and in need of discarding/cleaning(contaminated foods must be discarded)

- White and purple onions in bins
- Bulk paper bag of pinto beans
- Containers of peppers underneath the plastic containers
- Garlic in blue containers on dry storage rack
- Spices on the top rack of the dry storage
- Clean utensils on dry storage rack across from 3 compartment sink
- Opened pots of food items stored on the floor of the walk in cooler
- Opened sugar on top of soda syrup boxes
- Containers of chips under cookline
- Opened tortilla products at the end of the cookline on steam table
- Bags of Jamaica in bin below sprinkler

The following shall occur before contacting this department for reopening of the facility. Restore power to the facility, restore gas to the facility, discard all contaminated foods items, clean and sanitize all utensils at the facility. Once these item have been completed contact this department at (951) 461-0284 for re-inspection. Power observed turned on at the time of inspection.
